In this superb visual tour, readers will witness the process of decay and regeneration in the Thain Family Forest, the carpet of millions of naturalized daffodils on Daffodil Hill, the vibrant azaleas sheltered by majestic trees and dramatic rocks in the Azalea Garden, and the recently installed Native Plant Garden, which blends sustainable methods with thoughtfully planted native flora.

With an elegant design and immersive imagery, *Gardening With Nature* is a lavish tribute to this iconic New York institution and a necessary call to action to care for the ecosystems that surround us. Captured in sumptuous photography by Larry Lederman, the featured gardens are prime examples of world-class horticulture with rich history, but the sustainable techniques and nature-friendly plants are available to any reader or at-home gardener interested in nurturing the natural world in a serious yet accessible way.
