In Southern Interiors: A Celebration of Personal Style, the first book from acclaimed design editor Tori Mellott, creatives across the American South welcome readers into their private homes to share what Southern living means to them. Spotlighting 28 residences in country towns, coastal resorts, and major metropolises, this stunning new book features homes in a variety of architectural and interior design styles, from modern and minimalist to Georgian-inspired to Southern Gothic.

Each of the homes spotlighted in *Southern Interiors* illustrates how the region's traditions of hospitality and easy elegance are being interpreted by the South's most stylish people today. These deeply personal residences mix heirloom antiques with contemporary art, pair high-end furnishings with flea-market finds, and draw inspiration from a rainbow of color palettes.

Peek inside Beth Webb's coastal South Carolina getaway, artist Hunt Slonem's historic Louisiana manor, and fashion insider Ann Mashburn's airy Atlanta home. Among the many other luminaries featured in the book are interior designers Suzanne Kasler and Thomas Jayne, architects Stan Dixon and Bobby McAlpine, and tastemakers Elizabeth Damrich and Kerry Moody, just to name a few.

Shot by the world's top lifestyle photographers, the unforgettable images and immersive spreads highlight the unique features and special details in every home, both inside and outside. Alongside the photographs are short Q&As with the homeowners, who answer a range of thoughtful questions including, "How does your house embody Southern living?"; "What's a Southern rule you love to break?"; and "Share five things that bring you happiness at home." In addition to these interviews, the book opens with a foreword by celebrated interior designer Sara Ruffin Costello and a thoughtful and personal introduction by the author.

Following the successful release of Charm School: The Schumacher Guide to Traditional Decorating for Today (2023) and Blue and White Done Right: The Classic Color Combination for Every Decorating Style (2023), **Southern Interiors** is the third book to be published as part of a collaboration between Schumacher and Monacelli.
